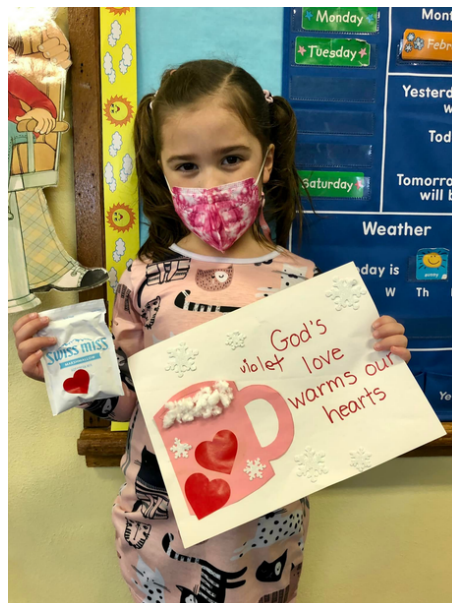
SPRING IS COMING!

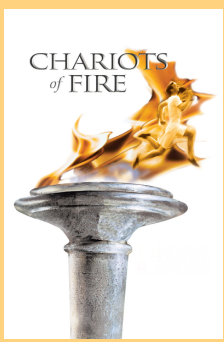

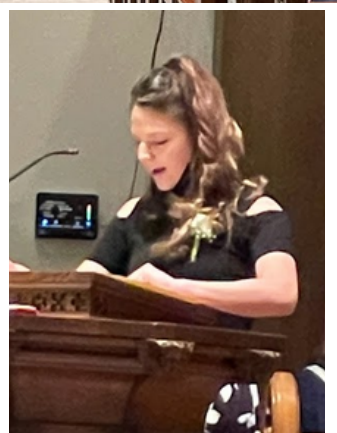


CONFIRMATION CLASS 2021-2022

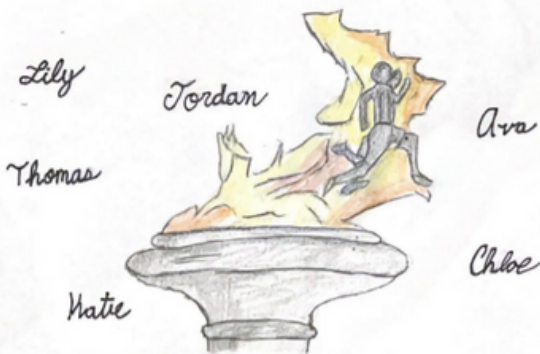

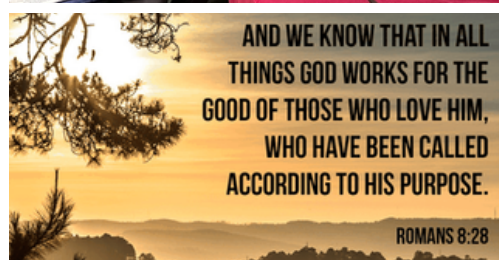

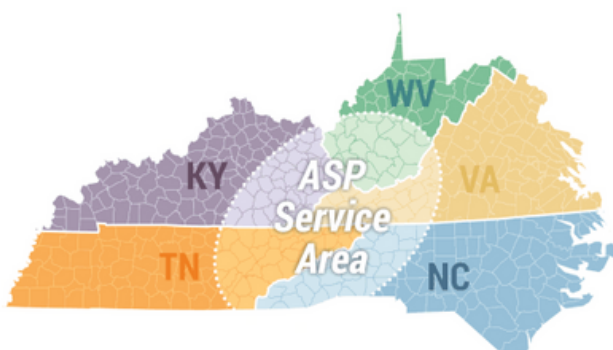
MISSION TRIP 2022
