Attached is a fiery chariot craft (minus the actual fire) and a coloring page. Enjoy!



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**A chariot of fire whooshed down from the sky! The strong wind and the chariot of fire carried Elijah up to heaven!**

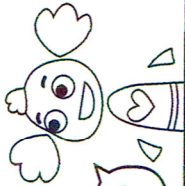

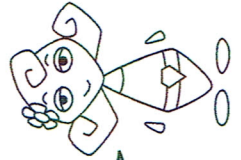

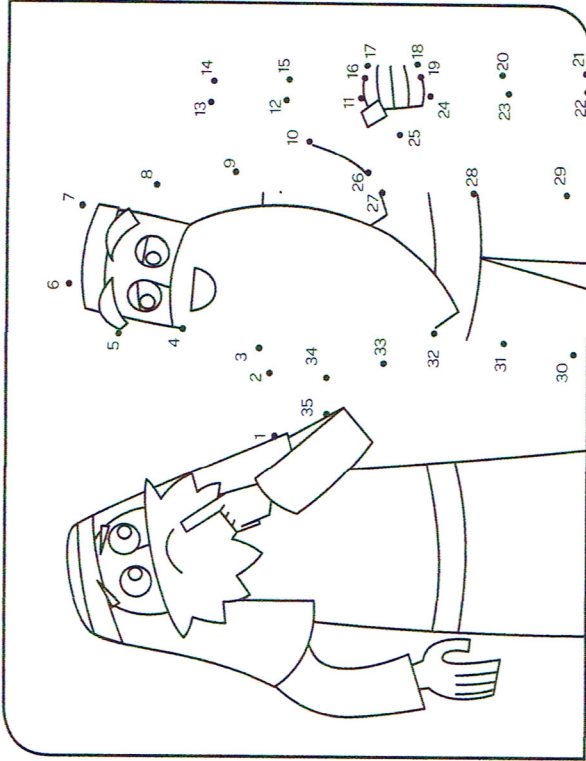
