I hope all of you know how much you are loved and missed! We can't wait to be all together at church again soon.

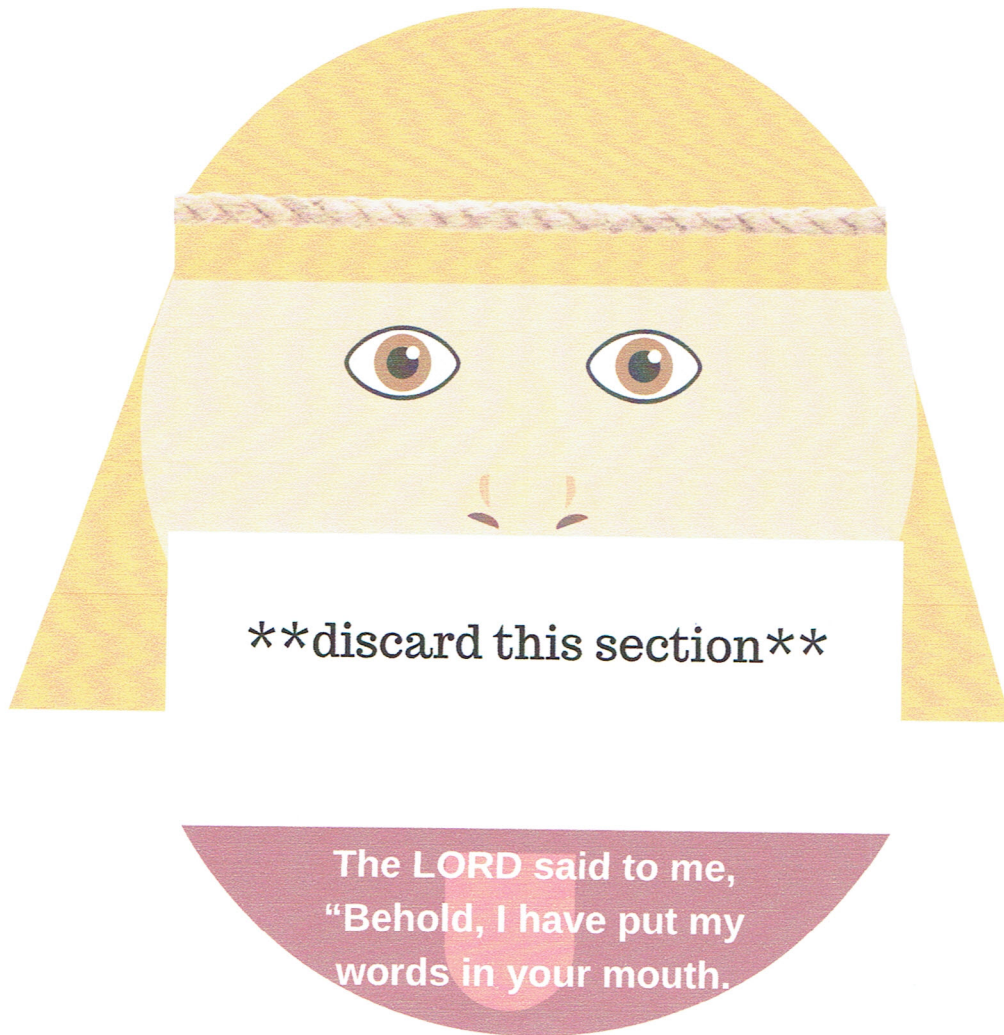
