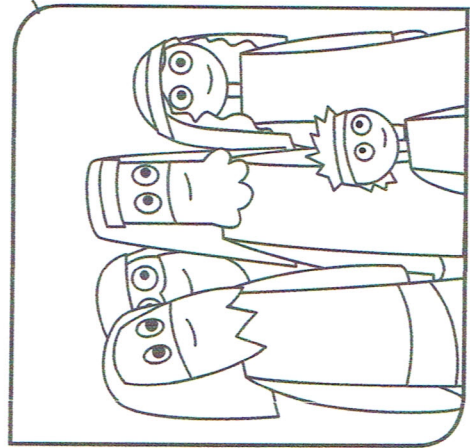
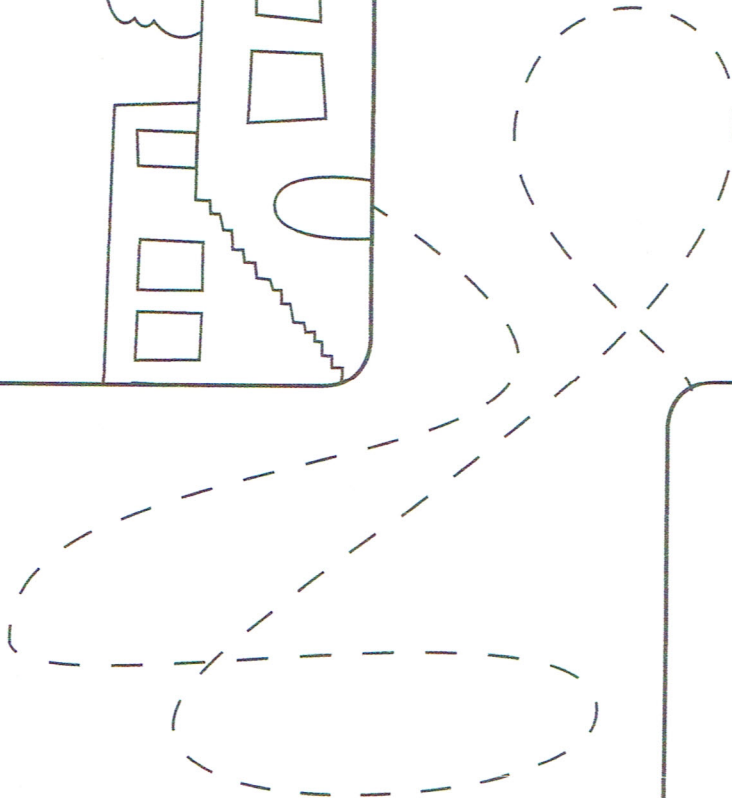
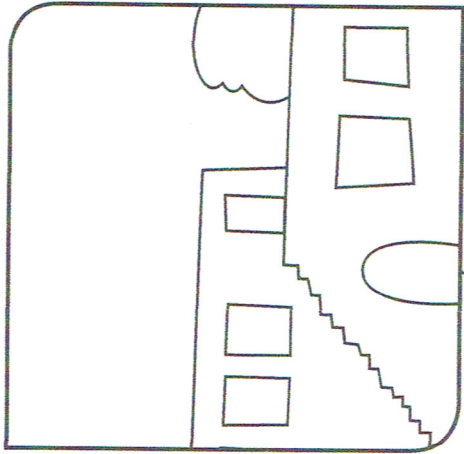
Finally Friends, please remember that God always delivers messages of hope. And that we are ALL welcome at God's house.

I hope all of you know how much you are loved and missed! We can't wait to be all together at church again soon.

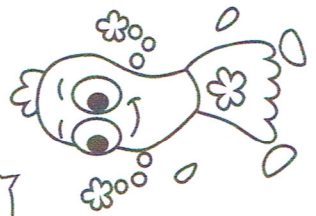
