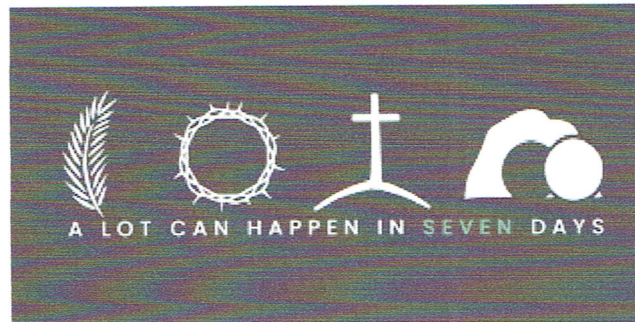


This Week in Sunday School - Holy Week - 3.28.21

God help me to love as you have commanded me to love.

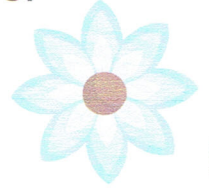

God please surround me with your peace.

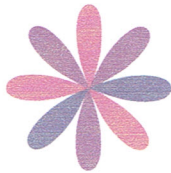
1 Peter 5:7
