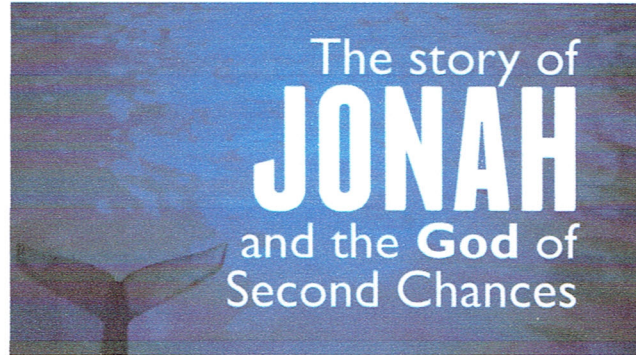


## This Week in Sunday School - 1.24.21 - Jonah

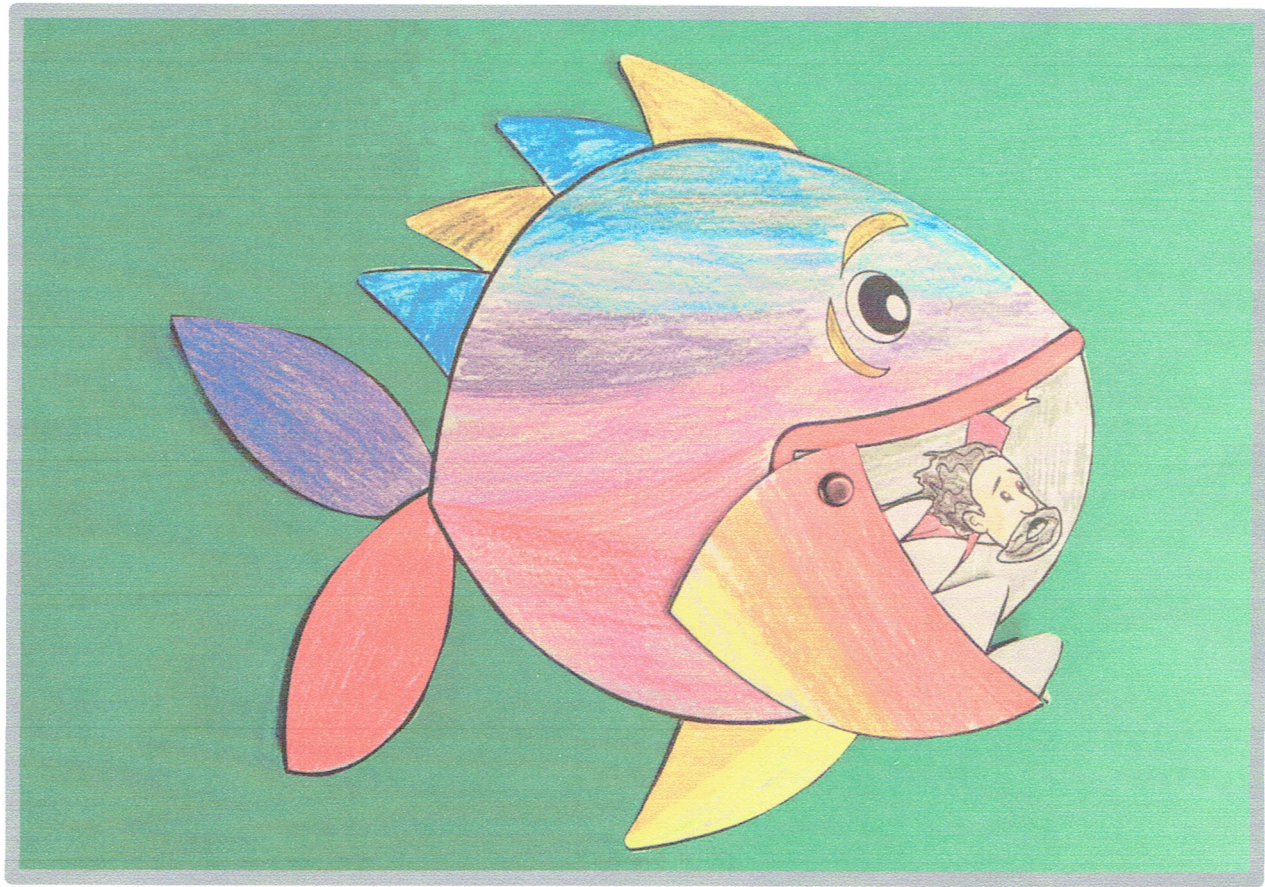

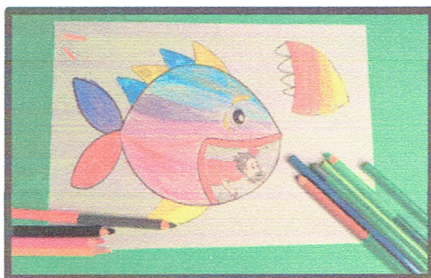
# Jonah and the big Fish



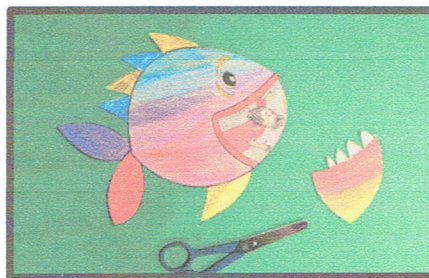
## What you need

## What to do



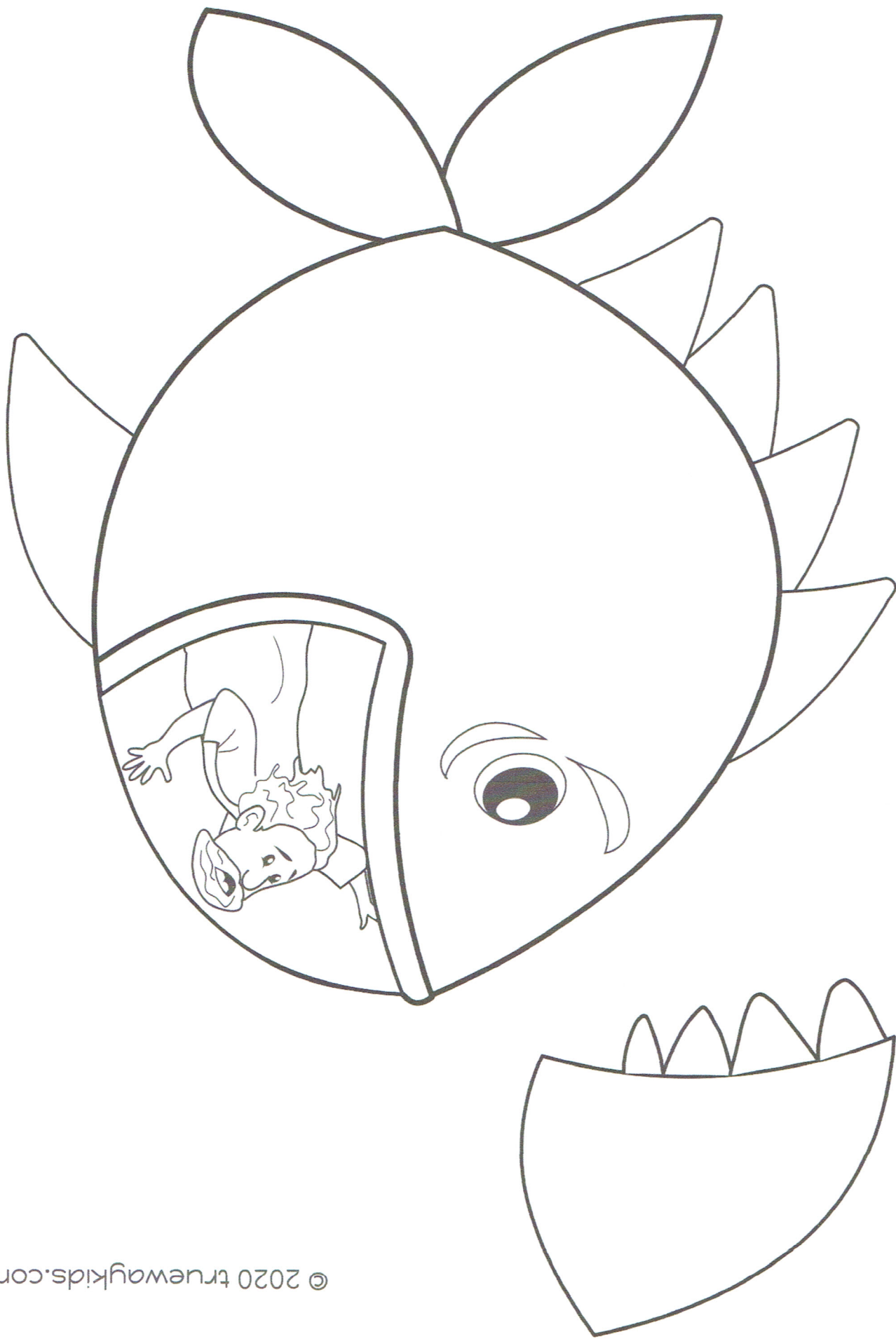
Color the template page.
