Happy Sunday, Friends,

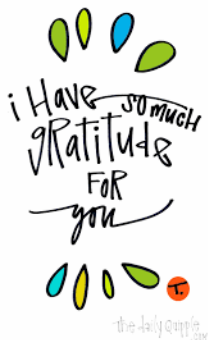
