

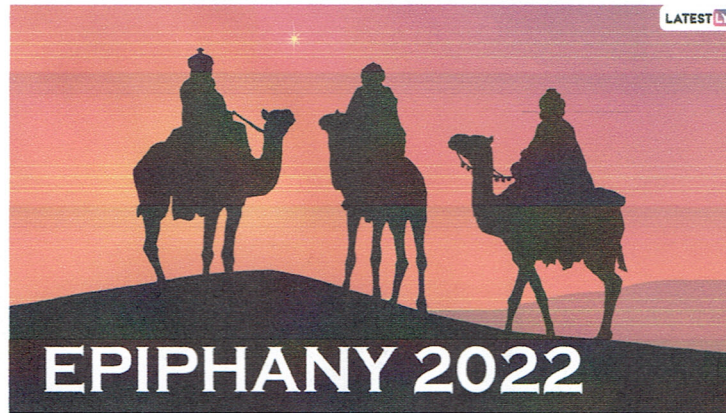
This Week in Sunday School 1.9.22 - The Wise Men and Epiphany

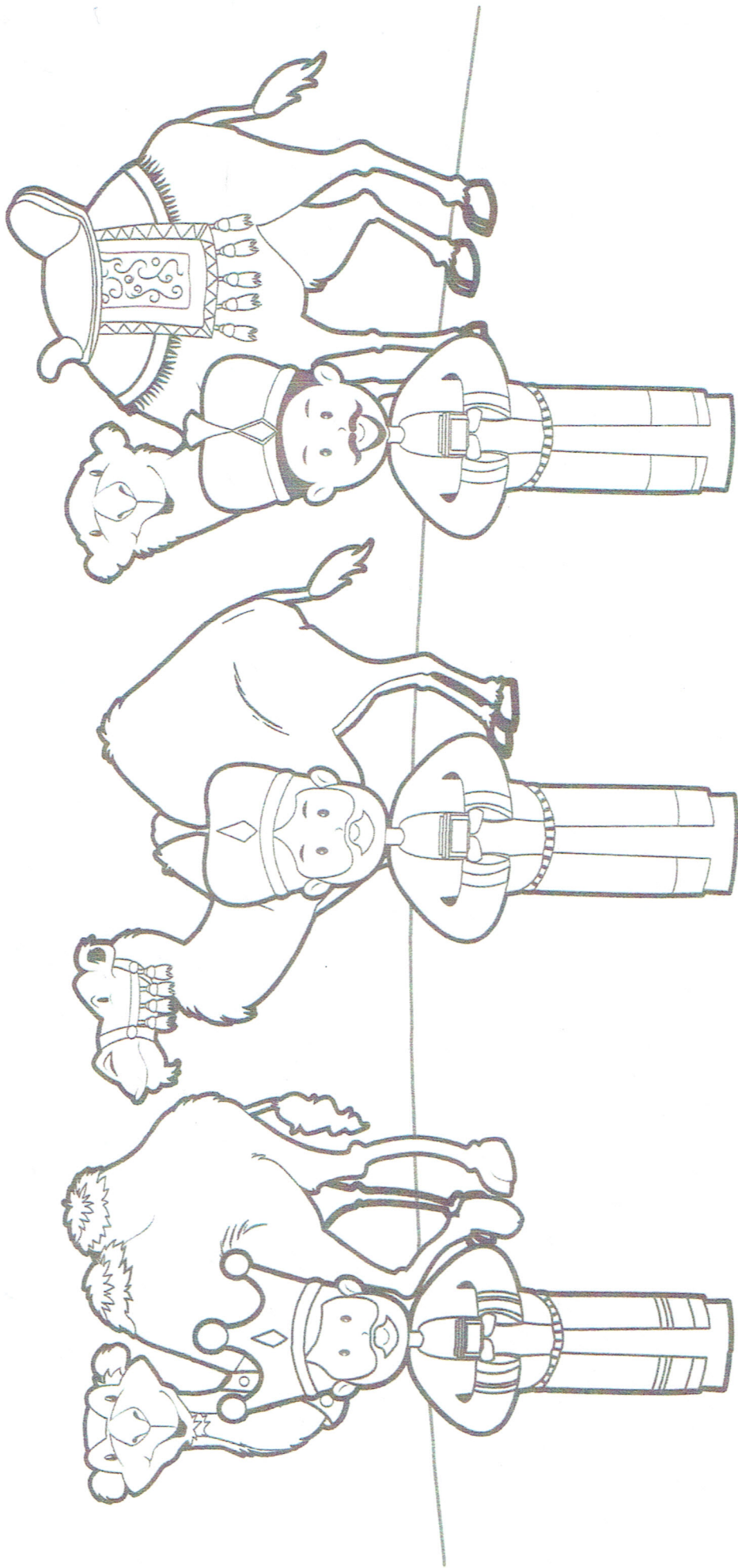
I hope you know how much you are loved and missed! We can't wait to be back at church together soon.

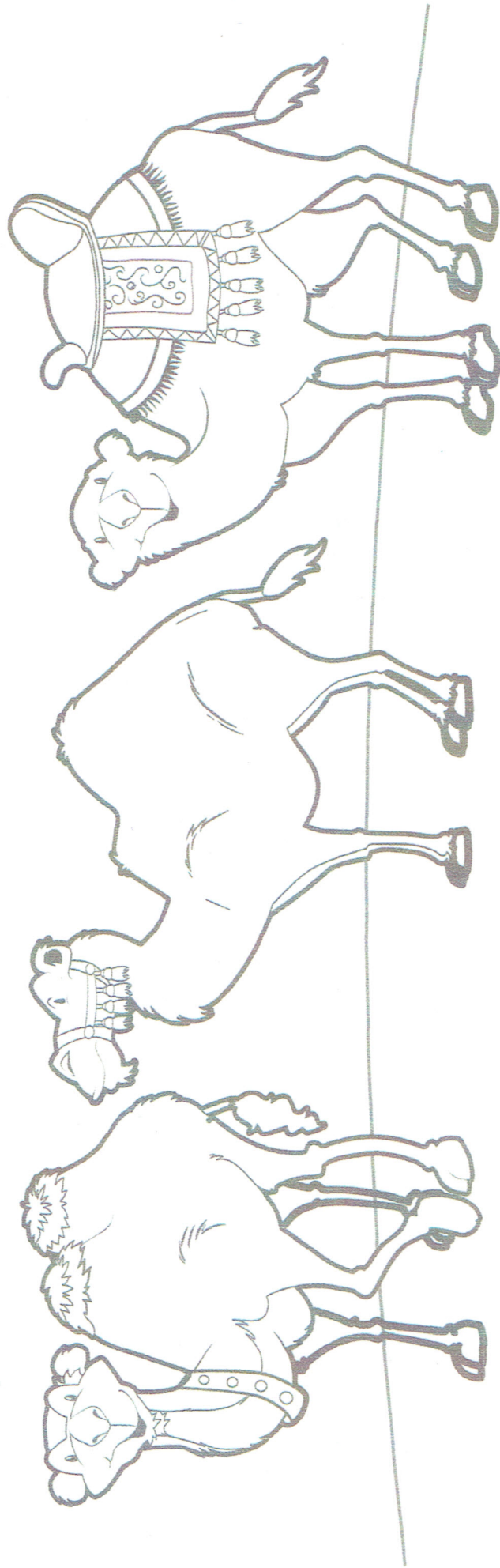
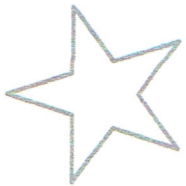

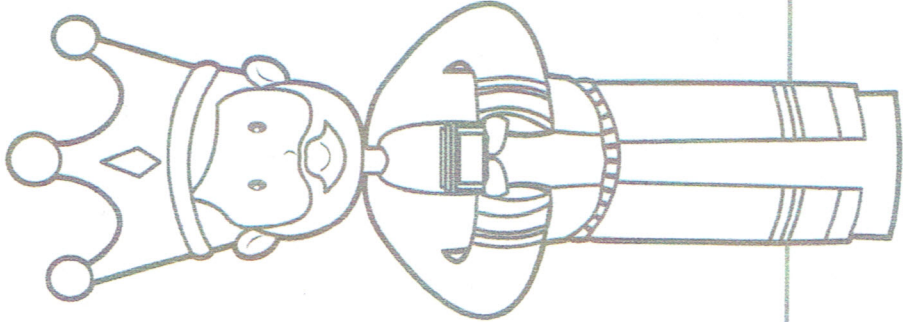
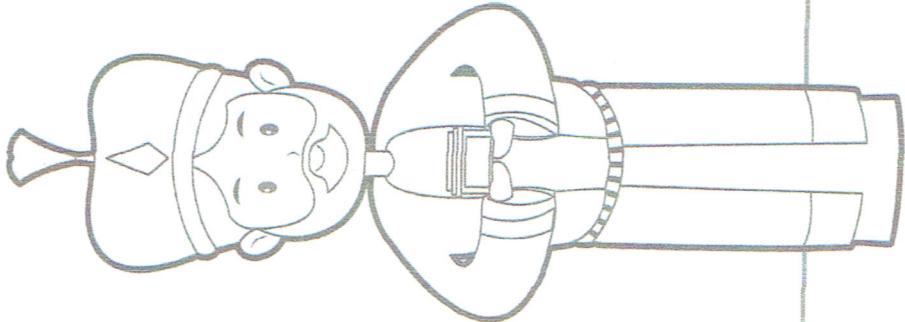
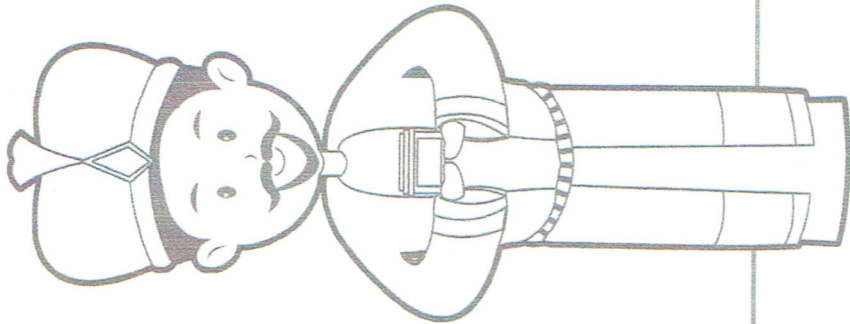
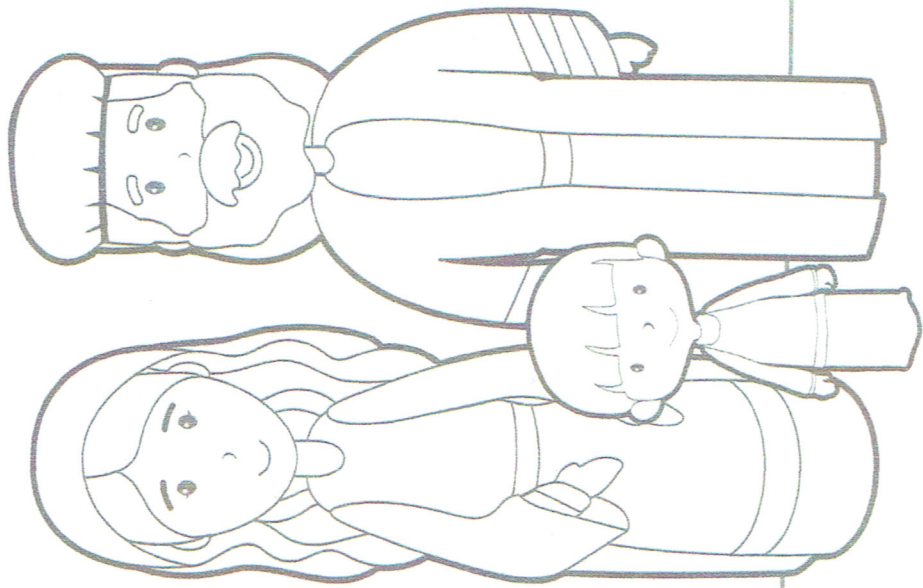


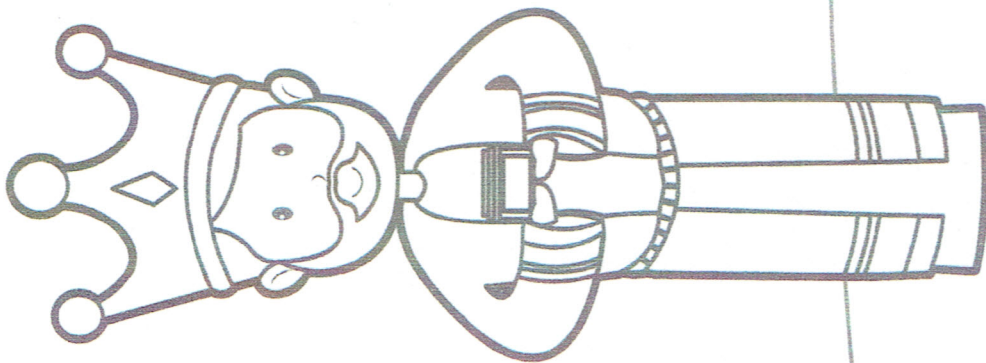
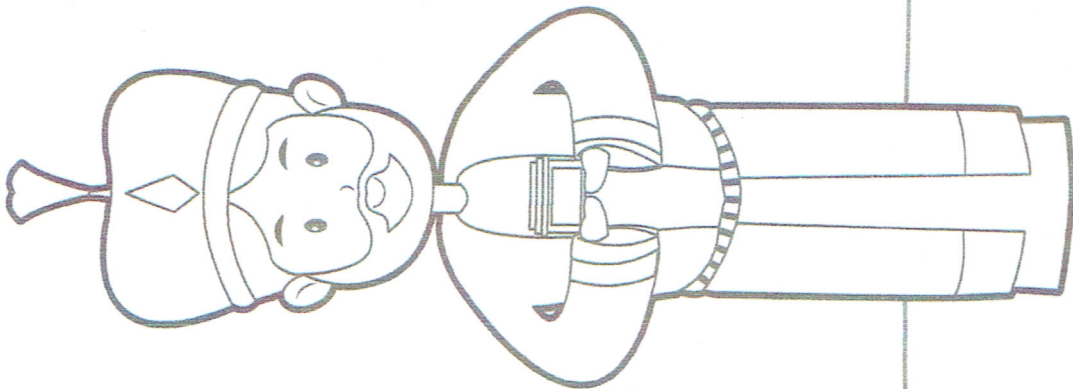
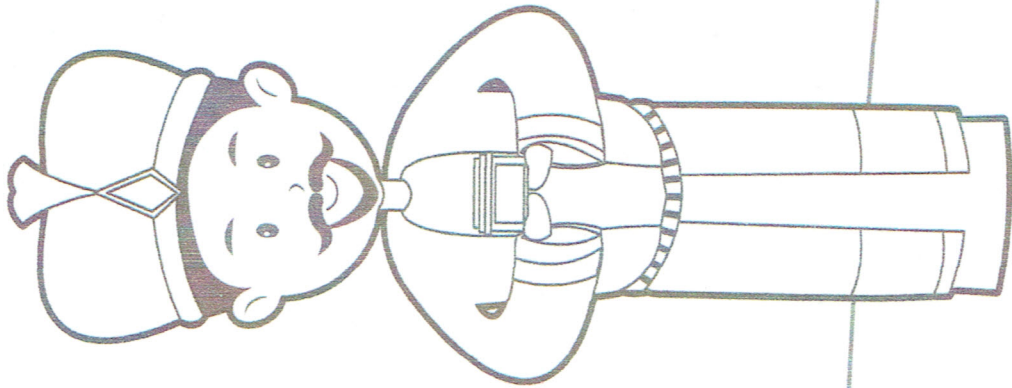
The wise men traveled a long way to bring gifts to Jesus. When have you gone on a trip?



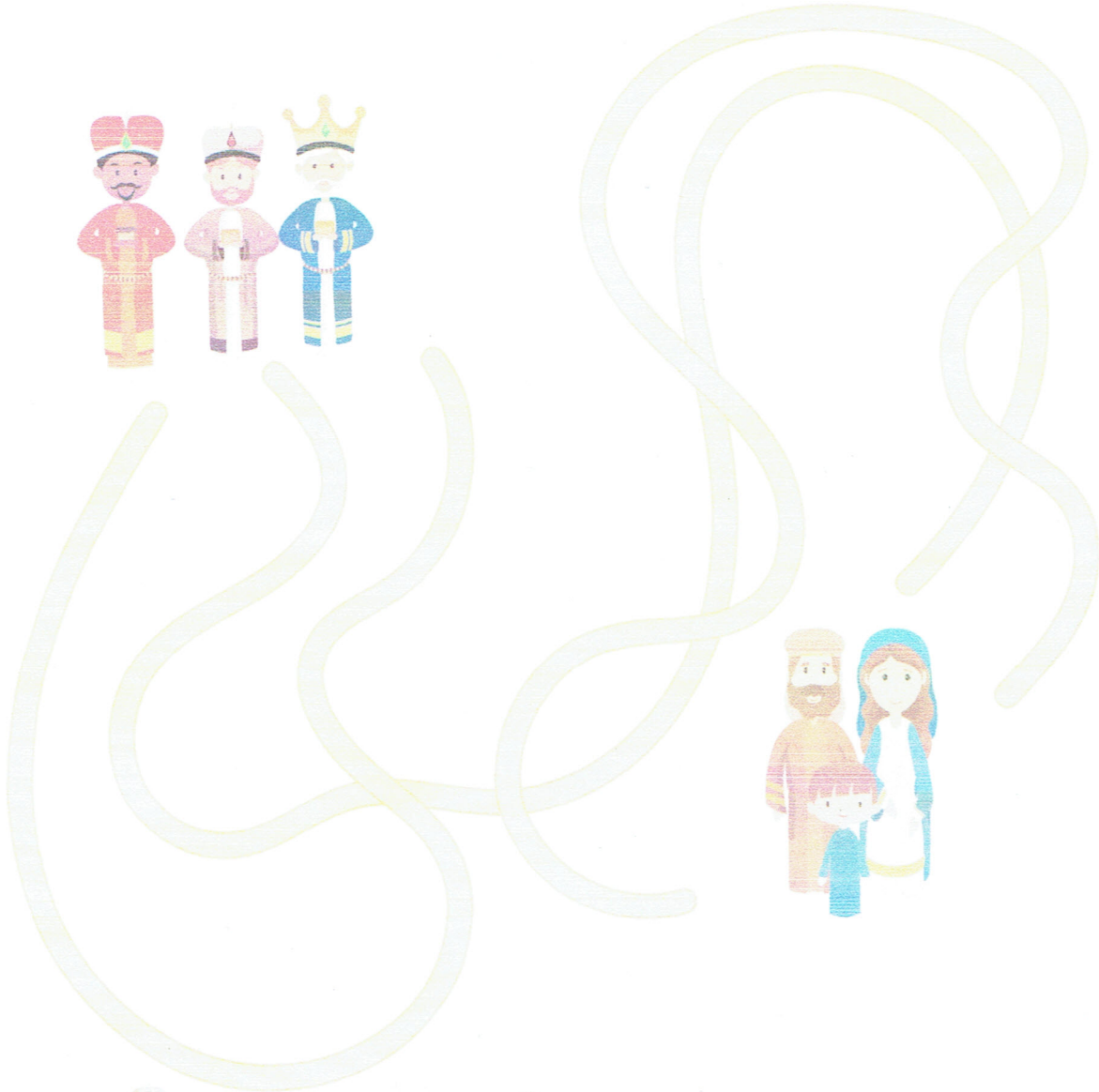




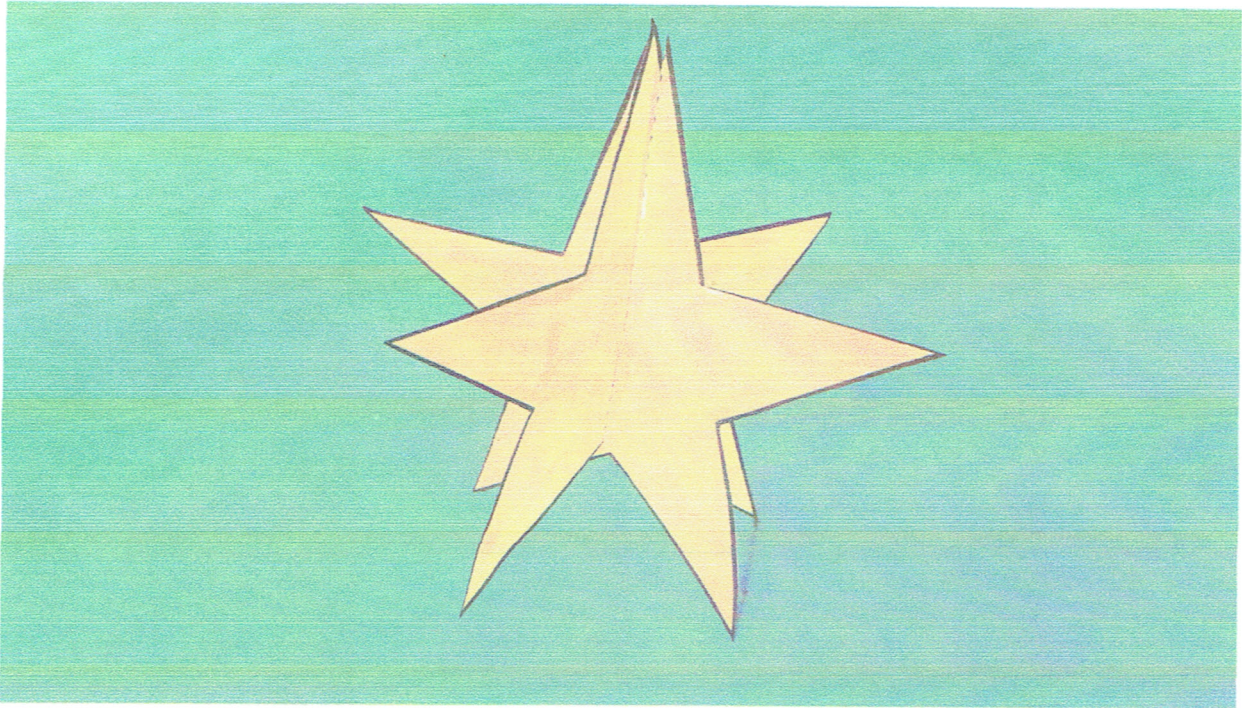




Which path leads the wise men to Jesus?



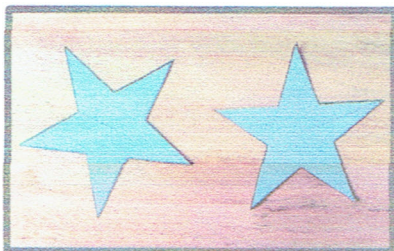
3D star craft



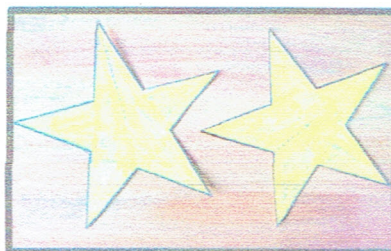
What you need

- Template printed onto card
- Pencils, crayons or paint
- Scissor
- Tape
- Optional: glue and glitter
- Optional: string

What to do



Cut out the star shapes from the template. (leave the dotted line until later).



Decorated both sides of each star. Optional use glitter and allow to dry.



Cut down the dotted line to the middle of each star. Insert stars together and tape in place.

Optional: Add some string to hang the star.
