Deacons seek to support others, sharing their gifts in a variety of ways. Some of our responsibilities include volunteering to assist weekly or monthly:

- *Delivery of flowers* after Sunday worship; especially at Christmas, Easter and other holidays.
- *Help serve communion* which is the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of each month.
- *Greet church members and visitors* prior to our 8:30am and 10:00am services.
- *Keep in touch with members unable to attend church with cards, phone calls or visits.*
- **Provide transportation** to or from church services for members who are unable to drive or don't have transportation options.
- *Usher* during the church service, collecting tithes and offerings.
- *Attend monthly Deacon meetings*, to work on the changing needs of the church.
- *Attend yearly leadership retreats* as suggested by our Pastor.
