Codicil to Your Will

(Sample Language for Inclusion in a Last Will and Testament)

If you are making one change to your will you can simply add a codicil stating the following:

I, _____, a resident of the County of Camden, State of New Jersey, hereby make and publish this First Codicil to my will dated _____, as follows:

I hereby amend my said will by adding a new paragraph at the end thereof to read as follows: (_____) I give, devise and bequeath the sum of \$_____ or % of my estate to FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH of Haddonfield, or its successor, for its general purposes.

Ratification. As amended by this First Codicil, I hereby confirm, ratify and republish my said will dated _____.
